

Gray Deer Card

Great Christmas or winter season card



Recommended products to complete this card.

- **Stamps:** Magical Meadow
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Cherry Cobbler, Pebbled Path, Basic White, Winter Meadow Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- **Stampin' Ink Pads:** Memento Black
- **Other:** Silver & White ribbon, Stylish Shapes dies (the largest square), adhesive of choice, dimensionals, snips, bone folder, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

Prep

- Card base - 11 x 4 1/4 Cherry Cobbler, score at 5 1/2
- Inside layer - 5 1/4 x 4 Basic White
- Pebbled Path layer - 5 1/4 x 4
- Winter Meadow DSP (the gray trees and deer page) - 5 1/8 x 3 7/8
- Cherry Cobbler square - 2 15/16 square
- For the greeting you can use Smoky Slate card stock or use the middle of the DSP page where it is mostly light gray/white. You will need about a 2 x 1 piece

Instructions

- Stamp Winter Wishes on the scrap DSP and trim with paper cutter or snips.
- Stamp trees on basic white for inside of card, I recommend stamping off lightly before stamping the inside of the card. **To "stamp off" ink your stamp**, press it lightly on scrap paper to get some of the ink off, then stamp your card. You will get a lighter image on your card.

- Adhere white layer to inside of card
- Take the DSP layer to the Cut & Emboss machine. **To die** cut lay the DSP on the black plate. Take the large square from the Stylish Shapes dies and put it around the deer. Make sure you leave at least an 1/8 of an inch below the die, also ensure the die is straight. Cover the DSP and the die with the clear plate, push all the layers into the machine, then start to crank the handle to feed the layers thru the machine. It will make noise, this is okay. When it is all the way thru, remove the clear plate and the die, set them aside. You should now have two pieces of DSP.
- Adhere the large piece of DSP (with the hole) to the Pebbled Path cardstock.
- Adhere the small piece of DSP to the small Cherry Cobbler piece.
- Use 5 dimensionals on the back of the small piece and adhere it over the hole on the large piece. Note: the die will have left some small dots around the cut out, use these on two sides to get your small piece straight.
- Adhere the Pebbled Path layer to the card base.
- Using the mono adhesive, attach the ribbon to the card. Just put some on the middle of the ribbon.
- Add 2 dimensionals to the back of the greeting, towards the center, and stick it on the ribbon.
- Stamp your envelope with the tree stamp. I recommend stamping off (see note above for info on “stamping off”) lightly before stamping the envelope.
